



# **Trailer Collection and Usage Instruction Sheet**

**Trailer Collection Location:** You can collect and return the trailer from the Loddon Shire Council's Boort Depot by prior arrangement, located at: 19-23 Victoria St, Boort.

- Banners
- Instructions
- Cable Ties

## **Trailer Adapter Use**

An adapter is provided to accommodate an alternative connection between a sevenpin round (trailer) and a seven-pin flat (vehicle) for the electrical connection.







## **Strapping the Tree Down**

**Important:** The tree must be securely fastened to the trailer prior to transport to and from the event.

## **Materials Provided:**

Ratchet Straps

#### Instructions:

# 1. Loop the Straps:

- Take the ratchet strap and loop it through the ring on the top tree.
- Loop the other end of the strap through the anchoring points on the base of the trailer.

# 2. Tighten the Straps:

- Use the ratchet mechanism to tighten the strap securely. Ensure that the tree is stable and will not shift during transport.
- o Cable ties have been provided if additional fixation is required.

## **Attaching Banners**

#### **Promotional Banners Provided:**

- 2 Larger Banners (Blue and Green) for the sides of the trailer
- 1 Smaller Banner (Orange) for the back of the trailer

**Important:** Banners should only be attached when the trailer is on display and must be removed during transport.





#### Instructions:

1. **Prepare the Banners:** Unroll the banners and identify the blue and green banners for the sides and the orange banner for the back.

## 2. Secure the Banners:

- o Attach the banners to the trailer rails using the provided nylon ropes.
- o Ensure they are securely fastened to prevent flapping during display.



# **Safety Tips**

- Always check that the trailer is securely attached to your vehicle before driving.
- Ensure that the tree is stable and secured for transport.
- Drive carefully, especially when turning or braking, to ensure the tree remains secure.
